Over the past year we have strayed somewhat from a few very important concepts. Those concepts involve putting our students in positions to feel and understand what a potentially

dangerous situation might feel like while at the same time keeping them safe and protected.

In order to accomplish the goal of effectively bringing an element of realism into our classrooms we will once again be implementing the use of **SAFETY EQUIPMENT** in the classroom.

Training with safety equipment affords our students many benefits:

- Gives them the opportunity to block and counter while also protecting hands and feet
- Helps students understand appropriate distance from a would be attacker
- Teaches automatic reaction which can only be learned through repetition
- Safety equipment provides something for our students to get excited about. Using safety equipment in our classrooms is essential to helping our students become comfortable and confident with their skills

In order to help all of our students order the necessary gear for their belt levels we have decided to bring the order process back into the karate school. Previously we asked students and families to order their gear on a website.

We found that this was confusing and that people were having a hard time understanding sizing of gear and exactly what gear they should be purchasing.

Bringing the order of gear back into the school will allow instructors to properly fit all of our students and also answer any questions that families might have about gear usage, gear requirements, and gear purchase. **Our Gear Requirements Are As Follows:**

By Gold Belt- Hand and Foot Gear

By Green Belt- Head Gear

By Purple Belt- Remaining Gear which includes shin guards, Chest Guard, mouth guard, and cup and supporter for males.

By bringing the ordering of the gear back into the school we have also decided to substantially lower the prices that our families will pay for gear when compared to the prices that you would have been paying if we had continued to use the gear website as we had previously done.

Using gear in the classroom will be a very useful and necessary part of our martial arts classroom and will provide all of our students with one more thing that they can enjoy and get excited about.

Ask in the office for order forms for your gear.

Decide which pieces of gear that you will purchase and please plan to pay at time of order.

On Saturday October 17th at 12 Noon we will be hosted a safety class for our students, families, and friends.




This is a class that is for children ages 5-12

Mr. Cornell Tests For A Black Belt In Another Martial Arts System

As you may know, Mr. Cornell is well accomplished in his tournament achievements, becoming a National & World Champion.



He competed in Japanese Styled forms in over 75 various national tournaments in what was the WSKF (World Sport Karate Federation) and NASKA - North American Sport Karate Association (biggest, longest running circuit in North America)

Years ago, I invited a 7 Time World Champion, Suzann Wancket-Yue to do a seminar in our karate school. I encouraged Mr. Cornell to pursue training with her in pursuit on his quest to cultivate his potential and challenge himself through competition.

For years, he traveled to Minneapolis 1-2 times/month to train and hone his skill in Japanese Forms competition. Mr. Cornell has been working over the last year to officially earn a Black Belt in her system Sho Rei Ryu to further his training and challenge himself.

The test will consist of basics, self-defense, target hitting, and 13 forms (yes, THIRTEEN!).



Some of the Midwest's Top Martial Artists (a lot National & World Champions) will be demonstrating as well.

You're invited to come watch. Video is not allowed, so if you want to see Mr. Cornell in action, please come attend as he and two others from Minneapolis test for Black Belt. There will be pictures taken.

On this date we will be hosting another Girl Scout presentation. This workshop is titled


Strong Body/Strong Mind Using Goals To Empower Your Life
